**RESOLUTION No. 523  
OF THE SENATE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WARSAW**

of 19 February 2020

**on amending Resolution No. 500 of the Senate of the University of Warsaw  
of 22 January 22 on the rules of recruitment for Doctoral Schools at the  
University of Warsaw in the 2020/2021 academic year**

Pursuant to Article 200, section 2 of the Act of 20 July 2018 – the Law on Higher Education and Science (consolidated text: Journal of Laws of 2020, item 85), the Senate of the University of Warsaw resolves as follows:

**§ 1**

In the Appendix to Resolution No. 500 of the Senate of the University of Warsaw of 22 January 2020 on the rules of recruitment for the Doctoral Schools at the University of Warsaw in the 2020/2021 academic year (UW Monitor, item 33), in point “4. Interdisciplinary Doctoral School”, point “4.3 Form of the selection process and the number of points that can be obtained” shall read:

“Maximum number of points that can be obtained in the selection procedure – 100 points:

- 1) Stage I – 40 points (the number of points needed to qualify for Stage II – 20 points);
- 2) Stage II – 60 points.”.

**§ 2**

The resolution shall enter into force on the day it is adopted.
