**RESOLUTION No. 537
OF THE SENATE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WARSAW**

of 29 April 2020

**on amending Resolution No. 500 of the Senate of the University of
Warsaw of 22 January 22 on the rules of recruitment for Doctoral Schools
at the University of Warsaw in the 2020/2021 academic year**

Pursuant to Article 200, section 2 of the Act of 20 July 2018 – the Law on Higher Education and Science (consolidated text: Journal of Laws of 2020, item 85, as amended), the Senate of the University of Warsaw resolves as follows:

§ 1

Resolution No. 500 of the Senate of the University of Warsaw of 22 January 2020 on the rules of recruitment for the Doctoral Schools at the University of Warsaw in the 2020/2021 academic year (UW Monitor, item 33, as amended) is hereby amended as follows:

1) in § 15:

- a) in section 1, point 9 shall be deleted,
- b) in section 5, in the first sentence, the words “section 1 point 8” shall be replaced by the words “section 1 point 7”;

2) in § 18, section 12 shall be added and read:

“12. For the purpose of verifying the identity of the candidate referred to in section 11, the candidate shall present an identity document to the chairperson or secretary of the selection team for inspection. If the selection process is conducted remotely in accordance with section 10, the chairperson or secretary of the selection team shall, at least three days before the qualification interview or qualification examination, require the candidate to send a colour scan of the candidate’s identity document sufficient to enable their identification to the email address specified in the request. In the case of a candidate who is not a Polish citizen, the required identity document shall be a passport. The scan of the identity document and all copies thereof shall be deleted upon completion of the selection process.”.

- 3) in the Appendix to the Resolution, in point “1. Doctoral School of Humanities”, in point “1.2. Required documents”, point 2 shall read as follows:
- “2) a description of the initial research project proposal, which comprises no more than 6,000 characters including spaces, together with a summary of the research project of 1,000 characters with spaces; the description shall contain the bibliography that is not included in the character limit;”.

§ 2

The resolution shall enter into force on the day it is adopted.
