**ORDINANCE NO. 186
OF THE RECTOR OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WARSAW**

of 27 December 2023

**on amending Ordinance No. 4 of the Rector of the University of Warsaw
of 13 January 2023 on the principles for awarding scholarships paid
from the Rector's Scholarship Fund**

Pursuant to § 36, section 1 of the Statute of the University of Warsaw (UW Monitor of 2019, item 190, as amended), it is hereby ordered as follows:

§ 1

In the Rules and Regulations for awarding of “Scholarships for Start” paid from the Rector’s Scholarship Fund, constituting an appendix to Ordinance No. 4 of the Rector of the University of Warsaw of 13 January 2023 on the principles for awarding scholarships paid from the Rector's Scholarship Fund (UW Monitor of 2023, item 7, as amended), § 1 is hereby amended as follows:

1) section 1, points 2 and 3 shall read:

- “2. “Scholarship for Start for Athletes” – intended for first-year students of the first-, second- or long-cycle studies as well as for first-year doctoral students enrolled in a doctoral school, who are outstanding athletes. A person who placed in a scoring position at the Olympic Games, World Championships, European Championships, or Polish Championships (but not lower than 10th place) shall be eligible for the scholarship, and, in the case of students, also provided that they are entitled to receive the rector’s scholarship in the academic year in which they apply for the “Scholarship for Start”;
- 3) “Scholarship for Start for Doctoral Students” – intended for first-year doctoral students enrolled in a doctoral school who, in the course of the recruitment process, obtained a score ranking within the top 20% of results among those admitted as of 1 October of the academic year in which the doctoral student is applying for the scholarship, separately for:
 - a) Interdisciplinary Doctoral School,

- b) Warsaw Doctoral School in Mathematics and Computer Science,
- c) and in all other cases: separately for each doctoral school, divided by academic disciplines.

- if the number of doctoral students eligible for the "Scholarship for Start" in a given group is not a whole number, it shall be rounded down to the nearest whole number, provided that the number of scholarship holders is not less than one; Only doctoral students who were admitted for the first time to a doctoral school within the limit of places specified in Appendix No. 1 to Resolution No. 17 of the Senate of the University of Warsaw of 20 January 2021 on admission rules to doctoral schools at the University of Warsaw (consolidated text: UW Monitor of 2023, item 43), and who commenced their education on or after 1 October of the academic year in which they are applying for the scholarship, shall be eligible to receive the scholarship;"

2) section 3 shall read:

"3. The Scholarship shall be awarded for the period of 12 months and paid in a single payment within 30 calendar days of its award.";

3) following section 5, section 6 and 7 shall be added and read as follows:

"6. In the case of the scholarship referred to in § 1, section 2, the benefit shall be granted on the basis of achievements obtained during the period from the commencement of education at the upper secondary school level until 1 October of the academic year in which the student or doctoral student applies for the scholarship.

7. A student or doctoral student may receive the scholarships referred to in section 1 only once at a given level of studies or during their studies at a doctoral school. Achievements that formed the basis for awarding the scholarship at a given level of studies may not be taken into account when awarding the scholarship at another level of studies."

§ 2

Appendix to the Rules and Regulations for awarding the "Scholarships for Start" paid from the Rector's Scholarship Fund shall read as set out in the appendix to the present Ordinance.

§ 3

The ordinance enters into force on the day it is signed.
